President Hogg, District 5, President Hogg had no business to discuss for District 5 to discuss.

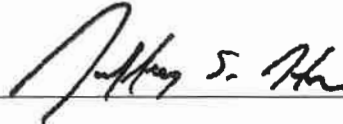
