

**ORDINANCE NO. 1942**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34-31 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
PERTAINING TO FISCAL YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, in the past the City has been on a fiscal year beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2009 the city changed the fiscal year to begin on January 1<sup>st</sup>, rather than October 1<sup>st</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, for budgeting purposes, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City to begin its fiscal year on October 1<sup>st</sup>.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHPORT,  
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Code Section 34-31 shall hereby read as follows on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set out verbatim.
2. That the change in fiscal year to begin on October 1<sup>st</sup> each year, and shall start on October 1, 2018.
3. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately.


