

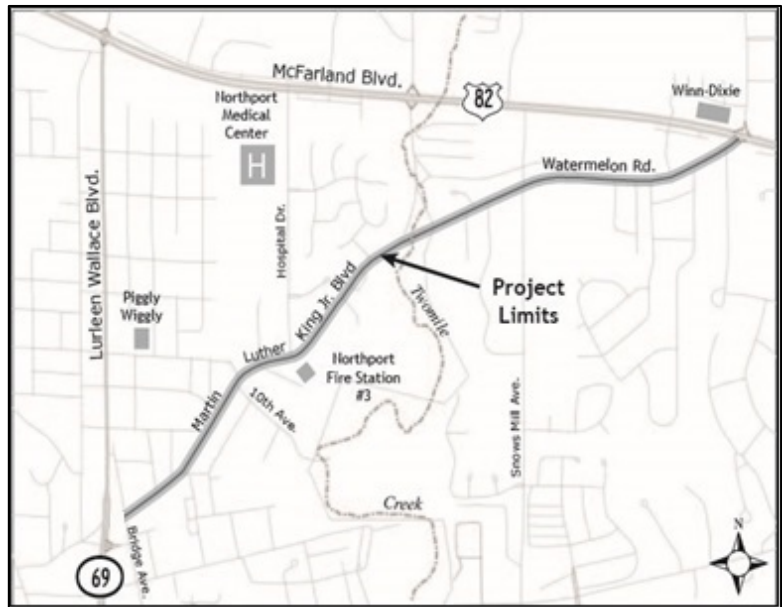
PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING
