WHEREAS, the City has previously used Sparyberry Educational Center as the polling place for District 2: and

WHEREAS, the Sprayberry Center is no longer used by the Tuscaloosa County School System and has been placed on the market for sale; and

WHEREAS, the New Zion Baptist Church, located at 1317 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. , is located in District 2; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously used Faucett-Vestavia Elementary School as a polling place for District 3; and

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County School System has asked the City to find an alternate location for this polling site; and

WHEREAS, Indian Lake Baptist Church, located at 3815 Watermelon Road, is in District 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Northport, Alabama, that the voting locations for all City of Northport Municipal Elections are established as follows:

District 2	New Zion Baptist Church
District 3	Indian Lake Baptist Church
District 4	Northport Public Safety Facility
District 5	Flatwoods Baptist Church

Summary: This resolution will establish the polling locations for all municipal elections. The City has previously used the Sprayberry Educational Center as the polling location for District 2. This site has been placed on the market for sale and is no longer in use by the school system. The City is proposing to move this voting location to the New Zion Baptist Church which is located on Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. The City has also previously used Faucett-Vestavia Elementary School as the voting location for District 3. The TCSS has asked the City to find an alternate location for this polling location. Indian Lake Baptist Church, located on Watermelon Road, has agreed to allow the City to use their gymnasium for this polling place.
