

The special meeting of the Northport City Council convened at 12:00 p.m. on September 1, 2016, at the Northport City Hall, located at 3500 McFarland Blvd. The invocation was offered by Interim City Administrator Hardy McCollum. Pro Tem Hogg led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were found to be present: Councilman Davis and Pro Tem Hogg. Councilman Hinton was present, via telephone. Mayor Aaron and Interim City Administrator were also present. Absent and failing to vote, President Logan and Councilman Davis.

The meeting was conducted pursuant to Governor Ivey's March 18th proclamation adhering to all safe social distancing practices. Temperatures were taken at the door, seats were placed at least 6 feet apart, and masks for all in attendance were required.

Motion by Councilman Davis, **Second** by Councilman Hinton, to **approve the agenda for the September 1, 2020 Council meeting**. Roll call vote was as follows: Councilman Davis, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; and Pro Tem Hogg. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Motion by Pro Tem Hogg, Second by Councilman Hinton to approve Resolution 20-66 canvassing the results of the 2020 Municipal Election for the City of Northport as follows: That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor, and that Bobby Herndon and Dale Phillips received the most and the second most votes for that office, respectively, and, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-21 et. seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended; that Christy Bobo received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member District 1 and is hereby declared duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday of November 2020; that Woodrow Washington received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member District 2 and is hereby declared duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday of November 2020; that John Hinton received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member District 3 and is hereby declared duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday of November 2020; that no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member District 4, and that Jamie Dykes and Mike Daugherty received the most and the second most votes for that office, respectively, and, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-21 et. seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended; that Jeff Hogg received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member District 5 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday of November 2020. Roll call was as follows: Councilman Davis, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; and Pro Tem Hogg, Yes. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Pro Tem Hogg wanted it stated for the record that he was voting yes to this resolution only for the number count of ballots, not the eligibility of candidates.


Motion by Councilman Davis, Second by Councilman Hinton to adopt Resolution 20-67 appointing Christy Bobo to the Northport City Council to fill the unexpired term of Councilman Tony Roberts for City Council District 1. Roll call vote was as follows: Councilman Davis, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; and Pro Tem Hogg, Yes. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Motion by Councilman Davis, Second by Councilman Hinton to adjourn the meeting. Roll call vote was as follows: Councilman Davis, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; and Pro Tem Hogg, Yes. Motion Carried Unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 12:07 p.m.
