

The special meeting of the Northport City Council convened at 12:00 p.m. on October 13, 2020, at the Northport City Hall, located at 3500 McFarland Blvd. The invocation was offered by Council President Jay Logan. President Jay Logan led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were found to be present: President Logan, Councilwoman Bobo, Councilman Hinton, Councilman Davis and Pro Tem Hogg. Mayor Aaron and Interim City Administrator were also present.

The meeting was conducted pursuant to Governor Ivey's March 18<sup>th</sup> proclamation adhering to all safe social distancing practices. Temperatures were taken at the door, seats were placed at least 6 feet apart, and masks for all in attendance were required.


