

The Special Organizational meeting of the Northport City Council convened at 5:30 p.m. on November 2, 2020 at the Northport City Hall, located at 3500 McFarland Blvd. The invocation was offered by Mayor-Elect Bobby Herndon, who also led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor-Elect Bobby Herndon was sworn in by the Mr. Scott Collins, Notary Public, State of Tennessee.

Councilwoman-Elect Christy D. Bobo was sworn in by Honorable Hardy McCollum, Retired Probate Judge, Tuscaloosa County.

Councilman-Elect John Hinton was sworn in by the Honorable Dennis Steverson, Circuit Judge, Sixth Judicial Circuit, Tuscaloosa County.

Councilwoman-Elect Jamie Dykes was sworn in by the Honorable Paul Patterson, Municipal Judge, City of Northport.

Councilman-Elect Jeff Hogg was sworn in by Mrs. Heather Tomlinson, Notary Public, State of Alabama.

Upon roll call, the following were found to be present: Councilwoman Bobo, Councilman Hinton, Councilwoman Dykes, and Councilman Hogg. Also present were Interim City Administrator Warren H. McCollum, Mayor Bobby Herndon. Absent and failing to vote, Councilman Woodrow Washington III.

Motion by Councilwoman Bobo, **Second** by Councilman Hinton **to elect Jeff Hogg to be the president of the Northport City Council.** Roll call vote was as follows: Councilwoman Bobo, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; Councilwoman Dykes, Yes; and Councilman Hogg, Yes. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Motion by Councilwoman Bobo, **Second** by Councilwoman Dykes **to elect Councilman Hinton as President Pro Tem of the Northport City Council.** Roll call vote was as follows: Councilwoman Bobo, Yes; Councilwoman Dykes, Yes; Councilman Hinton, Yes; and President Hogg, Yes. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Motion by President Logan, **Second** by Councilman Hogg **to approve Resolution 20-92 appointing Councilwoman Bobo to the Northport Planning and Zoning Commission.** Roll call vote was as follows: President Hogg, Yes; Pro Tem Hinton, Yes; Councilwoman Bobo, Yes; and Councilwoman Dykes, Yes. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Motion by President Hogg, **Second** by Councilwoman Bobo **to approve Resolution 20-93 appointing Members to Committees of Council.** Roll call vote was as follows: President Hogg, Yes; Councilwoman Bobo, Yes; Pro Tem Hinton, Yes; and Councilwoman Dykes, Yes. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Motion by Pro Tem Hinton, **Second** by Councilwoman Dykes **to approve Resolution 20-94 ratifying the use of the current depositories for municipal funds until such time as the Council permanently designates such depositories and designate the President, or in his absence, President Pro Tem to countersign checks.** Roll call vote was as follows: Pro Tem Hinton, Yes; Councilwoman Dykes, Yes; Councilwoman Bobo, Yes; and President Hogg, Yes. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**


Mayor Herndon presented Scott Collins, former City Administrator for the City of Northport, a plaque and thanked Mr. Collins for his service to the City of Northport.
